- 4. <u>ALL MEMBERS</u>: Members are reminded that under the new subscription dues plan, an annual member's dues expire on their anniversary date. Annual members are encouraged to renew their dues prior to their anniversary date to avoid a lapse in continuous membership. Officers and committee members, whose membership is not in good standing by reason to pay current dues by their anniversary date, shall forfeit eligibility to hold any office the remainder of the administrative year. In addition, every effort should be made to renew the membership of continuous members and sign up new and recover former members at all times during the year.
- 5. <u>ALL POSTS</u>: Department Senior Vice Commanders and Auxiliary Senior Vice Presidents have initiated a project to raise enough money to properly light each flag displayed at the 42 Single-Family Homes at the National Home in Eaton Rapids, MI. See the enclosed letter for more information.

Such other authorized person(s) shall be bonded with an indemnity company as surety in a sum at least equal to the amount of the liquid assets for which the Quartermaster by be accountable in accordance with Section 703.
